### 1. Format:

Check both paragraphs for format mistakes. If you find a mistake, label the mistake by adding a comment.

- Title (T)
- Indent (I)
- Complete Sentences (CS)
- Conjunctions (CONJ)
- Contractions (CONT)
- Direct Speech (DS)

## 2. Structure:

Check both paragraphs for correct paragraph structure. Follow the directions below. Label each point by adding comments.

- a. Find the **focused topic** in each topic sentence. Label it (FT).
- b. Find the **controlling idea** in each topic sentence Label it (CI).
- c. Read the supporting sentences. Add comments to label every **transition word**.
- d. Read the concluding sentence and label it (CS).

## 3. Expository Style:

Follow the directions below to check the Expository paragraph only. Add comments to label each point

- a. **WORD CHOICE**: Have you used third-person subjects? Label any first-person (I / my / me / we / us / our) or second-person (you / your) subjects and label it (WC) .
- b. **INFORMATION**: Have you used facts, evidence, and sources? Label any opinions or personal experiences and label it (INFO).
- c. **STYLE POINT**: Have you explained who, what, where, when, why and how? Label any generalizations and label it (G).
- d. Do you think your answer is creative and unique? Why or why not? Underneath your paragraph write a sentence to explain.

## 4. Descriptive Style:

Follow the directions below to check the Descriptive paragraph only.

- a. **WORD CHOICE**: Have you used at least one specific adjective or adverb per sentence? Label all the specific and descriptive words you can find. Label them (WC)
- b. **INFORMATION**: Have you described your senses and feelings? Label each emotion and comment (INFO)
- c. **STYLE POINT**: Have you used a simile or metaphor? label it (SIM) or (MET).
- d. Do you think your answer is creative and unique? Why or why not? Underneath your paragraph write a sentence to explain.
