



## 【The Sakasegawa River】

The Sakasegawa River, which runs near **Takarazuka Nishi High School**, had caused flooding many times. In 1897.

Hyogo Prefecture started the erosion control works on the river, which were the first in the Rokko Mountain System. In 1934, Japan's first flowing watercourse was constructed.

The Sakasegawa River now has a lot of structures to prevent erosion. Thanks to the river system management that had been done for years, the Sakasegawa River is now a clear stream where many fireflies can live.
