- Notes:
1. The sources of information are limited to NHK, Sun TV, or HP of Japan Meteorological Agency, which only issue according to city and town.
 2. If the warning issued is cancelled in only area (1) in the table above but still in effect in area (2), the students who live in area (2) have to stay home and their absence will be treated as an Official Absence and they will be excused from classes.
 3. When a warning is cancelled, classes will be taught according to the ordinary timetable.
 4. In case of extraordinary school cancellation during the examination term, details of the alternative schedule will be provided to the students.
 5. In the event that hazardous conditions may be present during the students' commute, the Principal will provide further instructions.
