

Measures for Temporary School Closures Due to Weather Warnings

1 Applicable Warnings

Heavy rain, flood, storm, blizzard, heavy snow, high waves, storm surge, major tsunami, tsunami

2 When a Warning is Issued in Ashiya City, Kobe City, or Nishinomiya City

Affected Students	If a warning is issued at 6:00 AM	If a warning is issued at 7:00 AM
All students	Stay at home	Temporary school closure

3 When a Warning is Issued in Cities Other Than Ashiya, Kobe, or Nishinomiya

Affected Students	If a warning is issued at 6:00 AM	If a warning is issued at 7:00 AM
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students residing in municipalities where warnings have been issued (excluding Ashiya City, Kobe City, and Nishinomiya City) • Students commuting through municipalities where warnings have been issued (excluding Ashiya City, Kobe City, and Nishinomiya City) 	Stay at home	Do not attend school (considered an excused absence) even if warnings are lifted in Ashiya, Kobe, and Nishinomiya.

4 If Warnings are Lifted in Ashiya, Kobe, and Nishinomiya by 7:00 AM

Arrive at 10:30 AM (HR classroom), classes start from the 3rd period (excluding students mentioned in 3).

- (※ 1) Classes will be conducted according to the regular class schedule.
- (※ 2) Measures during regular exams will be instructed separately.
- (※ 3) Other situations where student safety is at risk will be directed by the principal.
