3 When a Warning is Issued in Cities <u>Other Than</u> Ashiya, Kobe, or Nishinomiya

<ul> <li>Students residing in municipalities where warnings have been issued (excluding Ashiya City, Kobe City, and Nishinomiya City)</li> <li>Students commuting through municipalities where warnings have been issued (excluding Ashiya City, Kobe City, and Nishinomiya City)</li> </ul>	Stay at home	Do not attend school (considered an excused absence) even if warnings are lifted in Ashiya, Kobe, and Nishinomiya.

- 4 If Warnings are Lifted in Ashiya, Kobe, and Nishinomiya by 7:00 AM Arrive at 10:30 AM (HR classroom), classes start from the 3rd period (excluding students mentioned in 3).
