Hideki Matsuyama Is The First Japanese Golfer To Win A Masters Golf Championship

On Sunday, golfer Hideki Matsuyama won the Masters Tournament, making him the first Japanese man to win a major golf championship.

Matsuyama, 29, first played in the Masters 10 years ago. Since then, he's been improving his game. The Masters is one of the world's four most important golf championships. This year, the winner was given a prize of over \$2 million.



Philadelphia City Will Turn Off Lights to Protect Birds And Save Energy

Starting in May, many of the skyscrapers and other buildings in Philadelphia City in the U.S. will be going dark at night. People in Philadelphia City want to decrease energy use, but the main goal is to protect migrating birds. As many as one billion birds may die every year in the U.S. at night, because of flying into buildings. Bright city lights confuse birds.

So, now the city is beginning a program called Lights Out. Twice a year, for two months, when many birds migrate, the lights on many of the city's buildings will be turned off or dimmed from midnight to 6am. Many buildings will follow this plan this year in order to protect the birds.
