

# 伊和志津神社



- It was built in as early as the 9<sup>th</sup> century.
- It is said that Isoshionomi built the shrine.
- It is one of the Engishikinaitaishas, (the shrines which are included in the Engishiki Jinnmyo-cho )the oldest shrine in Takarazuka city.
- ”Honden”, the main building built in the Edo era, is one of the cultural assets approved by Takarazuka city.
- A lot of seasonal events are held there. Above all, the Setsubun-sai festival held on February 3, is very popular with local people.

Setsubun ; the day right before the beginning of spring (on the traditional Japanese calendar, normally around the beginning of February)
